- Must be a graduating senior 4-H member. Can be applied to any field of study at an accredited two- or fouryear college or university.

- Must be a graduating senior 4-H member. Can be applied to any field of study at an accredited two- or fouryear college or university.

- Must be a graduating senior 4-H member or a college freshman, sophomore, or junior during the year of application and enroll or be enrolled at the University of Florida or Florida State University. Can be applied to any field of study.

Nettie Ruth Brown Scholarship

- Must be a graduating senior 4-H member. Priority selection will be given to members, first from St. Johns

 four-year college or university.
- Preference will be given to members who have distinguished themselves scholastically, shown leadership potential, and demonstrated financial need.

Hillsborough County 4-H Foundation Youth Excellence Scholarship

Must have been in Hillsborough County 4-H for at least one year and enrolled in 4-H for at least two (2) years, volunteered in 4-H community service and excelled in primary project.

Tampa Bay Kennel Club Dog Scholarship

- ♦ Must be a graduating senior 4-H member or Florida 4-H Alumni and participated in the 4-H Dog Project.
- Preference will be given to members from Hillsborough, Pinellas, Pasco, Hernando, Polk, Sarasota, and Manatee counties pursuing animal related studies at an accredited two- or four-year college or university.
- Priority for those demonstrating a financial need will be considered.
- ♦ One (1) \$1000 Scholarship

Lakeland Winter Haven Kennel Club 4-H Scholarship

- Must be a graduating senior 4-H member or Florida 4-H Alumni and participated in the 4-H Dog Project.
- Preference will be given to members from Polk County, then Central Florida, then state-wide members pursuing animal-related studies at an accredited two- or four-year college or university.

Horseman of the Year

- Must be a graduating senior or junior 4-H member and completed at least 2 years in the 4-H Horse Project. Can be applied to any field of study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university.
- ♦ Previous 1st Place winners are no longer eligible for future Horseman of the Year awards.
- ♦ Sponsored by the Florida 4-H Horse Program with additional support from the DeBraal Family
 - 1st Place | One (1) \$800 Scholarship and \$200 Award
 - 1st Runner Up | \$200 Award
 - 2nd Runner Up | \$100 Award

Dallas C. Osborne 4-H Horsemanship Scholarship

- ♦ Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member who participates in the Area B Horse Program.
- ♦ One (1) \$500 Scholarship
