UF College of Agricultural and Life Sciences

- Must be a Florida 4-H member and a graduating senior in high school during the year of application.
 Students must be admitted to the University of Florida and major in an academic program in the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences.
- ♦ Four (4) \$1000 Scholarships (potential to renew each year)
- Sponsored by UF College of Agricultural and Life Sciences

Fred and Mabel Barber Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member and a graduating senior in high school during the
 year of application. Can be applied to any field of study at an accredited two or four year college or
 university.
- ◆ Two (2) \$1000 Scholarships
- ♦ Sponsored by Barber 4-H Endowment

T.G. Williamson Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member and a graduating senior in high school during the year of application. Can be applied to any field of study at an accredited two or four year college or university.

Thomas Greenawalt Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member and a graduating senior in high school during the year of application. Applied to any field of study at an accredited two or four year college or university

Platt Memorial Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a graduating senior 4-H member or a freshman, sophomore or junior in college during the year of application. Must be enrolled at the University of Florida or Florida State University.

Nettie Ruth Brown Scholarship Currently

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member who is a graduating senior in high school. Primary selection will be given to members, first from St. Johns County and then from District VI. If no suitable candidate is found, theselection process will be opened to 4-H members statewide.
- Preference will be given to members who have distinguished themselves scholastically, shown leadership potential as exhibited by their academic record and who have exhibited achievement and/or leadership abilities within 4-H; the greatest emphasis will be placed on academic excellence and preference for those with financial need.
- Applied to any field of study at an accredited two or four year college or university.

Terry Floyd Statewide Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member and graduating senior in high school during the year of application. Applied to anyfield of study at an accredited two or four-year college or university.

Terry Floyd Orange County Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member and Junior or senior in high school during the year of application. Applied to anyfield of study at an accredited two or four-year college or university.
- Four (4) \$500 Scholarships
- Youth must be from Orange County to receive the County Scholarship

Dr. Freddie Johnson 4-H Scholarship

- ♦ Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member and a graduating senior in high school in Pasco, Hernando, Citrus, Polk, Sumter, Marion, Orange, Osceola, Lake, Brevard, Seminole, or Volusia County. Applied to any field of study at anaccredited two or four-year college or university.

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member and a graduating senior in high school during the year of application.

- Applied to any field of study at an accredited two or four-year college or university.

Alden Hilliker Memorial Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a 4-H member and graduating senior in high school during the year of application.
- ♦ One (1) \$500 Scholarship
- Sponsored by Florida Association of Extension 4-H Agents (FAE4-HA)

Dr. Bobby Damron Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a graduating 4-H Senior or former 4-H member currently enrolled in college during the year of application.
- Must be accepted or enrolled in an accredited two or four-year College or university.
- Preference will be given to members of Alachua and Brevard Counties who participate in the Poultry or Clothing and Textiles Project. Attendance at 4-H University and the scholarship presentation night is important to donor.
- Two (2) \$500 Scholarships

Tampa Bay Kennel Club Dog Scholarship

- ♦ Eligibility Requirements: Must be a current or former 4-H member, graduating senior in high school or currently enrolled college student during the year of application. Financial need will be considered. Preference will be given to those pursuing animal related studies including pre-veterinary sciences.
- ♦ Preference will be given to members from Central Florida counties (Hillsborough, Pinellas, Pasco, Hernando, Polk, Sarasota, and Manatee). If no suitable candidate is found, the selection process will be opened to 4-H members statewide

Ruth Milton Scholarship

Horseman of the Year

- Eligibility Requirements: Must have completed at least junior year of high school and have completed at least 2 year in the Horseproject, including the current year.

Teki Hinton Ericson 4-H Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a current 4-H member and rising or graduating senior in high school, or currently enrolled incollege, not more than 3 years as 4-H alumni during the year of application.
- Applicant should be enrolling or enrolled in an accredited traditional college/university or technical/vocational program
- One (1) \$1000 Scholarship awarded
- Preference will be given to members from Hillsborough County. If no suitable candidate is found, the selection process will be open state-wide.

Lakeland Winter Haven Kennel Club 4-H Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Must be a current 4-H member and a graduating senior in high school, or currently enrolled in college during the year of application. Preference will be given to those pursuing animal-related studies, including pre-veterinary science.
- ♦ Two (2) \$1000 Scholarships awarded
- Preference will be given to members from Polk County. If no suitable candidate is found, the selection process will be open to Central Florida, then state-wide.
- Must have actively participated in the 4-H Dog program.

Hillsborough County 4-H Foundation Youth Excellence Scholarship

- Eligibility Requirements: Current 4-H member (Junior or Senior in High School) or 4-H alumni (enrolled in first three (3) years of post-secondary education). Must have been in Hillsborough County 4-H for at least one year and enrolled in 4-H for at least two (2) years, volunteered in 4-H community service and excelled in primary project.
- ♦ This award may be granted up to two (2) times to the same individual

Hal Porter 4-H Scholarship
