			taken away.  The ballots with the removed candidate are then counted towards the candidate based of the 2 <sup>nd</sup> ranking.  If a majority is reached, then winning candidates are confirmed.  If a majority is not reached, then rounds continue to take place.  Rounds will continue until a majority is reached.  Each subsequent round will consist of removing the candidate with the lowest number of votes and distributing their ballots based off the next highest ranking.
