## Categories

- **Personally Sewn: Traditional Clothing** – Garment sewn by the 4-H member. Entry can be one piece outfit or a number of coordinated pieces.
- **Personally Sewn/Constructed: Cosplay, individual OR group up to 5** – Costume sewn/constructed by 4-H members.
- **Wearable Art: Embellished** – Decorate a garment using arts and crafts techniques (i.e., dyeing, embroidery).
- **Repurposed** – Design and sew a wearable garment from previously used materials. Completed garment is different from its original use.
- **Needle Arts** – Garment is knitted, crotched, or weaved and an outfit is coordinated around this garment.
