

## Fostering Kits - Activity 2



### *Volunteer to take care of orphaned kits at a shelter*

Animal shelters and animal control often have orphaned wildlife or domestic animals that are sent to them. When they are faced with this situation they often have a contact list of dedicated individuals who are willing to care for and foster these animals till they are old enough to feed on their own and be released into the wild. Contact your local shelter or animal control center, explain that as part of your rabbit project you have learned how to hand-feed baby rabbits and that you are willing to donate your time to help foster an orphaned baby rabbit. Leave the center your information so that they may contact you in such an event.
